College Scholarship Application & Guidelines
Application Deadline to Headwaters SWCD: Friday, March 29, 2024

Purpose: To promote the education of Virginia citizens in technical fields with natural resource conservation and environmental protection.

To give financial support to students majoring in or showing a strong desire to major in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.

Qualifications: Individual applicants must be Virginia residents and full-time students enrolled in or who have applied to a college freshman level curriculum. Applicants shall document a class ranking in the top 20% of his or her graduating class or a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement. The applicant's most recent official school transcript must accompany the application. A copy of a school transcript will not be accepted. Applicants shall demonstrate active interest in conservation.

Only one applicant per district may be submitted. Applications should be made from the county the student resides or attends school. Eligible applicants must reside or attend school within a local Soil and Water Conservation District.

It is the responsibility of the districts to screen applications for eligibility in accordance with the criteria stated herein. Applications not fulfilling minimum criteria shall not be considered.

<u>Amount Awarded</u>: Four \$2,000 scholarships will be given to statewide winners. Two scholarships are awarded on behalf of the VASWCD Education Foundation and two scholarships are awarded on behalf of the Virginia Chapter of the Soil & Water Conservation Society. A check will be issued directly to the selected institution of higher education on behalf of the student.

Headwaters Soil and Water Conservation District Scholarship Program

Qualifications: Individual applicants must be full-time students enrolled in or who have applied to a college undergraduate level curriculum. Applicants shall document a class ranking in the top 20% of his or her graduating class or a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement. The applicant's most recent official school transcript must accompany the application. A copy of a school transcript will not be accepted. Applicants shall demonstrate active interest in conservation and should be pursuing a major in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.

Eligible applicants must reside or attend school within the boundaries of the Headwaters SWCD (Augusta County, the City of Staunton, and the City of Waynesboro). **Preference may be given to applicants who have not previously received a Headwaters SWCD scholarship. Applicants may only receive a Headwaters SWCD scholarship a maximum of two (2) times.**

Headwaters SWCD Education Committee will review and screen applicants for eligibility in accordance with the criteria states herein and will make the selections for the recipient(s) of this year's Headwaters SWCD scholarships. Applications not fulfilling minimum criteria will not be considered. The points indicated on the application will not be used in the selection of the Headwaters SWCD Scholarship but will act as a guide for the committee.

Amount Awarded: The Headwaters SWCD will award one \$1,000 scholarship to an eligible individual.

Deadlines:

Late May, 2024	Scholarship award winners will be announced

Submitted applications will be reviewed and screened by the Scholarship/Awards Committee. All applications and information contained therein shall remain confidential. Nominations from the Committee will be submitted to the VASWCD Educational Foundation Board of Directors for final approval.

NOTES:

The guidelines/criteria for the VASWCD Educational Foundation Inc. Scholarship Program **only** allow applicants who have applied to a college freshmen level curriculum to apply for the four (4) two thousand dollar (\$2,000) scholarships. These scholarships are only offered to graduating high school students/high school seniors/current college freshman.

The Headwaters SWCD Scholarship guidelines/criteria allow full-time students who have applied to a college undergraduate level curriculum to apply for the Headwaters SWCD Scholarship Program. This scholarship is offered to a graduating high school student as well as college freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors. Preference may be given to applicants who have not previously received a Headwaters SWCD scholarship. Applicants may only receive a Headwaters SWCD scholarship a maximum of two (2) times.

The same application form is used for both the Headwaters SWCD Scholarship Program and the VASWCD Education Foundation Inc. Scholarship Program. Applicants must only submit one copy of the application to the Headwaters SWCD for consideration for one or both scholarships. The points indicated on the application will be used in the selection of the VASWCD Scholarship. The points indicated on the application will not be used in the selection of the Headwaters SWCD Scholarship but will act as a guide for the Education Committee.
